PURPOSE:

To advise the field about the "KITTING" program available from RCD for developing parts lists for previously stocked take apart kits and tear down kits.

BACKGROUND:

For some models RCD had stocked complete kits for such functions as tear downs, and take aparts. These kits were comprised of o-rings, gaskets and miscellaneous parts for completing the desired task. These kits were generally ordered under a single part number through the parts ordering system. To better utilize inventory these kits have been eliminated and replaced with a program that generates a list of parts needed to accomplish the desired task.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The “KITTING” program is available by signing on to “IMS.” This is selection “B” on the main menu. Next, enter “/FOR C9OKIT” followed by the “ENTER” key. For more detailed information about “Kitting,” a complete instruction manual is available by calling or coining your RCD account representative. After a kit is selected a complete bill of material will be developed which then can be manually ordered.

The “KITTING” program allows the service office to generate a bill of material for a certain task within minutes. It allows better use of RCD’s inventory and assures that if a certain part is needed as an individual item it is available and not tied up in a kit. “Kitting” also eliminates the need to rework kits due to voided and /or superseded parts.

The “KITTING” program is available for use now on 17DK,DM,DR,FA,EX; 19C,D,DA,DG,DH, DK,DM,DR,EA,EB,EX,FA,XL,XT,XR AND XRT; 23XL.
